





DRAGON SLIPPERS
JESSICA DAY GEORGE

This caught my eye when it was released in hardcover. I took it home, read a couple of pages, got sidetracked on something else and forgot about it. Tidying the shelves at work one day, I came across the paperback edition, which has a very different cover and I didn't recognise the title or author. I read the back and thought, "I have to read this". I quickly scanned the first page, realised I'd read it before, put two and two together and realised I was really meant to read this book.

This is not one of those stories where the girl is saved from a dragon by a handsome prince, to be whisked away and live happily



ever after. Creel, our young heroine, is left as a sacrifice to the local dragon - by her aunt. Creel is an orphan and her aunt and uncle are poor, so her aunt (who reads trashy romances) decides to sacrifice Creel to the dragon, so that she'll be rescued by a local nobleman, who will then be obliged to marry her, ensuring Creel's (and her aunt's and uncle's) financial security. Creel bravely faces the dragon, discovering they don't hoard gold - this one has a hoard of shoes Imelda Marcos would be proud of, and being a clever lass, does a deal with it. She will tell the young prince coming to rescue her (and kill the dragon) that the dragon is in fact already dead, if it gives her a pair of shoes so she can walk to Kings Seat where she plans to find employment doing fancy needlework. She tries on many pairs of shoes, but the only pair that fit comfortably is a pair of blue slippers. The dragon is reluctant to give them up, but honours their deal. It is a long and dangerous journey for a young woman on her own and on the way she is attacked by some young men. As she runs, she wishes to be saved and at the last moment a golden dragon named Shardas rescues her. She spends a month with him making samples of her work, before he takes her to Kings Seat, with a promise that if she ever needs him, all she has to do is call his name.


Creel is apprenticed to the specialist dressmaker who caters for all the nobility. She quickly earns a name for herself as a gifted embroiderer and makes friends with some of her co-workers and Prince Luka (whom she met through a series of mishaps when she first arrived in the city). The Roulainian princess Amalia, who is being married to Luka's older brother to shore up shaky relationships between the two countries is – lets just say a bit spoilt... She sees Creel's shoes and wants them, bribing one of Creel's co-workers to steal them. This is when things start going very wrong for the kingdom, for the slippers are very special. Whoever possesses them can control dragons and Princess Amalia and her father have their eye on Kings Seat.

This was a brilliant story and had me hooked from the first sentence to the last. George has managed to tweak a familiar storyline just enough that's it recognisable, but has elements that are fresh and exciting. The whole cast of characters were brilliant, whether good or evil (when Creel says she's going to hit Amalia, I was hoping for a couple of black eyes to get dealt out). I liked the fact that characters that could have been used to gain the reader's sympathy weren't good, that some who seemed shallow had depth and that George made the point that history can be recounted different ways, depending on your point of view. Just fantastic! I can't wait to see what the author does next! - Stephanie

CLASSIC TITLE
THE FOREVER WAR
JOE HALDEMAN

It's 1996 and the beginnings of human space exploration have encountered a hostile alien presence. Soldiers are conscripted from the crème of the populace and packed aboard crude warships to do reconnaissance and engage the enemy where encountered.

The story follows grunt William Mandella's journey from conscription, through training and his campaign against the



mysterious Taurens, named after the constellation from which they where first discovered.

The lives of the soldiers sent to do battle against the distant enemy are cut off from humanity by the long periods of time which pass as they move though space near the speed of light.

The book begins as the soldiers are sent to train on an uninhabitable planet. Harsh military drills against practice drones and the extreme dangers of working in the alien environment result in many casualties via mishap or live weapons training. Those who do survive are immediately packed off to war.

A long haul through space follows, broken by a short chaotic period of combat. The soldiers that, through sheer luck, manage to survive, return home to an Earth which they no longer understand. Famine, overpopulation and resulting war have ravaged the planet.

Mandella, among many other veterans, is alienated by this new environment. Feeling no connection to his fellow Earthers, he opts to reenlist for this war, for which he has now little or no respect. Given the low rate of survival and the length of his tour, he expects he will probably not survive to return to Earth anyway.

During a period of time experienced by Mandella as just four years, over a millennium has passed on earth. Technological developments and space travel have changed every facet of life on Earth. Regardless of the outcome of the war, the lives of the surviving soldiers have been changed forever.

This book was written in 1974 by Joe Haldeman. A veteran of Vietnam, much of the description of life in the military and of combat was adapted from his own experience of war. The motives of the military are called into question, and given the current world situation, the message of this book is just as relevant today as it was 33 years ago.

This is a great book regardless of whether you enjoy space opera or just want to read a great novel, a classic of the genre. - *Geoff*






